## Update on the recent TCI Half yearly meeting in Malta

The amendments to the rules were discussed in depth and most will go through to the AGM. It was felt by the meeting that the constitution should remain as is, even if it means the same wording is shown later in the rules.

A discussion was held to add a new amendment to change the date of the financial year bringing it forward to allow TCI to prepare the final accounts and send them out to countries before the meeting. The TCI board agreed to discuss this and bring this forward as a new rule change at the AGM.

Minor amendments were proposed for some of the suggested rule changes, however the majority of the proposed rule changes were thought to be a good idea and the meeting felt they should be brought to the AGM in June. Due to the lateness of the TCI AGM the full details of these will not be provided to us before our agenda is issued, however we will supply the most up to date information to you within our AGM Agenda. The exec apologise to those attending this meeting who did not get the agenda in a timely manner allowing them time to prepare in advance, we will do better next time, we promise.

As soon as the minutes are available from the meeting these will be circulated to each club.

Please remember that if your club has any thoughts on any of the TCI rules and wish to put forward a new rule or amendment that this needs to be sent to our executive by the due date 3rd January in order that this can be brought forward at our AGM.
